Maths Curriculum Intent

By the end of their learning journey in maths, we intend for our students to be expert problem solvers who are able to reason, interpret mathematical literature, communicate mathematical concepts and model real-life situations using mathematics.

Students will develop skills in numeracy, logical reasoning, mathematical resilience, critical analysis, interpreting maths, and mathematical modelling.

Students will develop knowledge and understanding of the main branches of mathematics: number, fractions, decimals and percentages, algebra, calculus, geometry, trigonometry, statistics and probability.

Maths at WMG Academy is special because we embed life skills lessons into our curriculum, giving students exposure to – sometimes surprising – contexts in which maths can be used. We also push the most able to new heights through a focus on mathematical rigor, appropriate challenge, and powerful enrichment opportunities. We offer further maths at GCSE and are able to offer entrance exam support to those students looking to go to top universities.

Beyond the curriculum, we give students the opportunity to participate in various maths challenges, including the intermediate and senior individual challenges, as well as any relevant Olympiads. We also encourage and support students participating in team challenges, including the Maths Team Challenges, Ritangle, and the National Cipher Challenge.
