# Teaching & Learning

Our teaching and support staff work towards a common goal – to ensure every student maximises their potential to enable them to access their chosen career pathway.

Qualifications focus around the STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths). Students at GCSE level study core subjects of including English Language and Literature, Mathematics, Science and Engineering Manufacture and a choice of additional option subjects.

Those joining the Sixth Form have a choice of A-levels, vocational courses or a combination of both. Alternatively, they can choose a large vocational/technical qualification such as the T-Level in Engineering.

Our curriculum is co-planned with our employer partners and designed to bring real-life experiences into the classroom. The input from employers allows students to see first hand how the knowledge and skills they learn in the academy's relates directly to workplace practice.
